



## 2024 SAG-AFTRA SPECIAL CONVENTION SPEAKERS LIST POLICY

### CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS & RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE

#### Procedures for Designating Speakers for Debate on Proposed Resolutions

1. Subject to the rest of this policy, the Speaker List posted on the online Convention portal at [sagaftraconvention.org](https://sagaftraconvention.org) prior to the adjournment of the 2023 Convention will be carried forward to the Special Convention. All additional requests to speak in debate on any proposed resolution must be submitted through the Convention online portal at [sagaftraconvention.org](https://sagaftraconvention.org), except as otherwise authorized by the CARC. Additional requests to speak in debate must be submitted through the Convention online portal no later than 5:00 pm PT on Monday, June 10, 2024. The final speaker list will then be determined by the proponent and CARC as outlined below.
2. Any previously listed speaker who is either no longer available or no longer wanting to speak to the listed resolution, should email [Resolutions@sagaftra.org](mailto:Resolutions@sagaftra.org) no later than 7:30 am PT on Saturday, June 22, 2024 and 7:00 am PT on Sunday, June 23, 2024 for any remaining resolution.
3. If, in the intervening time since the adjournment of the 2023 Convention, any proponent has decided to withdraw their resolution, they should email their request to the CARC at [Resolutions@sagaftra.org](mailto:Resolutions@sagaftra.org) for its consideration and approval.
4. The proponent of any proposed resolution, or their designee, shall be entitled to take the floor first in support of their proposed resolution, and shall be considered the first of the two speakers in favor permitted by the Convention Rules.
5. The second of the two speakers in favor permitted shall be designated by the proponent from among those individuals who have requested to speak as set forth in section 1 above. Proponents must notify the CARC of designees or designated speakers in the manner and by the deadline designated by the CARC.

6. If there is no additional speaker who has requested to speak in favor or if the proponent does not designate a second speaker, the CARC may designate an individual to speak on behalf of the CARC, if the CARC has recommended in favor of the proposed amendment or resolution.
7. If the CARC has recommended against the proposed resolution, the CARC shall be entitled to designate an individual to speak on behalf of the CARC as the first of the two speakers in opposition permitted by the Convention Rules.
8. Regardless of the recommendation of the CARC on a given proposed resolution, if more individuals have requested to speak in opposition to the proposed resolution than there are available slots to speak, the CARC shall designate speakers for each remaining slot in opposition to the proposed resolution.
