

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

<u>Effective May 1, 2005</u>, Producers will be charged a minimal payment of \$425 to defray costs incurred by SAG-AFTRA in filing its security interest. SAG-AFTRA will deduct this amount from the security deposit at the time the balance of the account is returned to the Producer.

The following is a breakdown of the minimum costs incurred:
