3 WAYS TO TAKE ACTION

1. EDUCATE

Make sure you're familiar with some of the great features your specific Local Corporate/Educational Code has to offer.

The main benefit to an employer is the ability to hire a "mixed cast." This allows a producer to hire you without having to put everyone under a union contract. Only professional performers are covered.

2. CONNECT

Email our digital postcard to your potential employers.

Since much of the work captured under the Corporate/Educational contract is due to an employer's interest in hiring you, make sure your network of employers is aware that there's a Local Code that offers simplified rates with flexibility that allows them to hire you.

3. ENGAGE

Take every opportunity to audition.

Submit yourself for any type of corporate and explainer video work. Simply include a note with your submission letting the employer know you're a SAG-AFTRA member and that there's a great Local Code employers can use that makes it easy and affordable to work with YOU.
