² If initial compensation is freely negotiable and is negotiated above applicable State minimum wage rates, it is commissionable provided that such compensation above minimum wage may not not be put towards compensation that would be due for other services or uses, e.g. overtime, penalties, fees, promotional appearances, merchandising, or re-use

^{*}Overscale initial compensation does not equal overscale residuals. These guidelines are based on the assumption that the agent has not negotiated residuals terms greater than CBA terms. Agents may commission (a) any overscale residual payment they have negotiated above SAG-AFTRA minimums (b) any residual payment based on over scale original employment payment. Applies only to reuse of a program as a whole, and not to the use of an excerpt of one program in another program.
