

TV/THEATRICAL/STREAMING

Series regulars who are required to relocate away from home for work (except when going to L.A.) may be paid a relocation allowance in lieu of per diem, lodging, and transportation to and from set.

Beginning with seasons commencing principal photography on or after January 7, 2024, the relocation allowance may be no less than \$5,000 per month for up to six months, up to \$30,000. The relocation allowance is per season, and there is no limit on the number of seasons.

If you are on location for less than two weeks of a month, this monthly amount may be pro-rated.

EXCEPTION: If you received the maximum number of relocation allowances due under the 2017 or 2020 agreements, you do not qualify for the new provisions. As a reminder, under the 2017 and 2020 agreements, the relocation allowance was \$10,000 per season for either two seasons (orders of more than 13 episodes) or four seasons (orders of 13 episodes or fewer).

As always, these amounts are minimums and you or your agent may always negotiate for higher amounts.
