The 1st Vice President, by virtue of election to that position, is eligible to serve as an Alternate National Board Member.

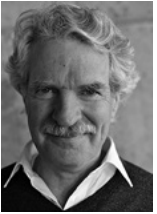

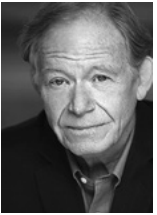
