- If any SAG-AFTRA contract claims are not met, SAG-AFTRA has the right to demand binding arbitration to enforce the collective bargaining agreement at no cost to you.
- Flexible and low-budget contracts covering work with emerging filmmakers through the student, short, ultra-low and new media contracts.
- Advocacy for members against discriminatory employment practices and commitment to working for increased employment opportunities for SAG-AFTRA's diverse membership. SAG-AFTRA strives to protect, strengthen and enforce the non-discrimination and equal employment provisions in all union contracts.
- Lobbying on local, state, and national issues that impact performers' lives including free speech, intellectual property rights including digital theft, media consolidation, runaway production, access to health care, pension protection, restrictive contracts, child performer protections and artists' rights.
